Rules:

1. As a result of the Exotic Newcastle Disease quarantine release and to prevent future outbreaks of the disease, all fairs are required to have poultry inspections upon arrival at the fair prior to coop-in for symptoms of disease or illness. Any suspected animals may be dismissed from the fairgrounds. (Dept. of Food & Ag. Memo F2004-05, F2005-06 & F2007-03)
2. Rules, definitions and judging procedures as prescribed in the latest edition of the Official Show Rules and the Standard of Perfection of the American Poultry Association, Inc. shall apply to the Butte County Fair poultry shows, except in such instances where they are in conflict with the rules and regulations prescribed by the Department of Food and Agriculture.
3. Birds will be shown and judged in the proper divisions and class for breed, variety, age and sex ONLY. If no class is offered, no award may be made. Disqualified birds and those absent at the time of judging do not count when computing the number of exhibitors in the class.
4. A judge may excuse a bird from competition if it appears to be fatigued or out of condition, but the bird shall be counted as an entry.
5. For all classes of standard-bred chickens, turkeys, ducks, and geese, all birds must be identified by the leg bands conforming with the entry form on arrival at the show.
6. Definitions: Cock and Hen; Old Cock and Old Hen; Old Drake and Old Duck; Old Gander and Old Goose... 1 year and over. Cockerel and Pullet; Young Cock and Young Hen; Young Drake and Young Duck; Young Gander and Young Goose...under 1 year.
7. Danish system of judging.
8. All State and local rules apply.
9. Prospect birds do not compete for champion. Serama Table top show will be on Sunday, August 26th, at 2pm.
